

History findings

- 27 year old nulligravid solicitor, currently in a stable relationship of four years duration.
- 11 month history of deep dyspareunia
 - occurring every time she has intercourse
 - worse with positions leading to deeper penetration
 - pain lasts only a few minutes afterwards
- Regular menstrual cycle 5/28, no menorrhagia, but dysmenorrhoea which has become worse over the last 2 years. Pain located centrally for 3 days and most months also in the right iliac fossa for 1-2 days. Uses Ibuprofen 400mg TDS for analgesia. No IMB, PCB, cyclical PR bleeding or haematuria.
- No history PID or symptoms suggestive of infection.
- She uses condoms for contraception and due to her and her partners careers, they are not planning children for the next few years.
- No previous gynaecological history. Appendicectomy at a teenager. Smears normal. Sister has endometriosis.
- No other medications or allergies. Non-smoker. ½ bottle wine per day.
